The Expanded Learning Division (EXLD) of the California Department of Education (CDE) is pleased to announce the release of the After School Education and Safety (ASES) Frontier Transportation Request for Applications (RFA) for funding beginning in the 2019-20 fiscal year. The ASES Frontier Transportation RFA is to provide supplemental funding for existing ASES grantees that have transportation needs due to their after school program site being located in Frontier areas as specified in California *Education Code* Section 8483.7(a)(6).
