## What's New & Current Events

### Policy Committee Membership

## New Legislation

Two bills have recently been approved by the legislature that pertain to after school. Below is a summary of the bills:

- **Senate Bill 816 (Statutes of 2018): A cleanup bill created by the Policy Committee**
  - Changes the provisions of fiscal agent change allowing ASES grantees to transfer a subset of sites to another existing grant, given that all parties approve.
  - Changes “Summer” to “Summer/Supplemental”
  - Changes the language from the Summer/Supplemental grant to eliminate a dollar cap and keep it at 30 percent of the base grant amounts.

- **AB 2622 (Statutes of 2018): For Frontier ASES sites (schools with 11 pupils per less per square mile)**
  - Allows frontier ASES sites to close their program at 5 p.m.
  - Changes their attendance targets for reductions: from 85 percent to 65 percent for the two consecutive years and from 75 percent to 55 percent for most recent year.
