Yesterday, President Donald Trump released his [proposed budget](#) for fiscal year 2020. The budget calls for a complete elimination of the Federal 21st Century Community Learning Centers. Trump's proposal would eliminate after school programs for over 1.7 million children and youth nationally, and eliminate over \$130 million dollars in funding to California, eliminating programs at approximately 740 sites, including over 300 High Schools.
